With the construction of the new world-class terminal building, which broke ground last December 2017,  
**CLARK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**  
is projected to accommodate  
**8 MILLION PASSENGERS** per annum.



At the core of this Freeport is the **NEW CLARK CITY**, which will bring in hundreds of enterprises around a sprawling industrial and real estate development.
