GUIDELINES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 23, SERIES OF 2024 "IMPLEMENTING A DIGITAL AND INTEGRATED SYSTEM FOR THE PREBORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING OF ALL IMPORT COMMODITIES"

WHEREAS, Administrative Order (A.O.) No. 23, series of 2024 (s. 2024), "Implementing A Digital and Integrated System for the Pre-border Technical Verification and Cross-border Electronic Invoicing of all Import Commodities," was issued by the President of the Philippines to further strengthen national security, safeguard consumers' rights, and protect the environment against sub-standard and dangerous imported goods;

WHEREAS, Section 101 of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10863 or the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act" (CMTA) directs the State to develop and implement programs for the continuous enhancement of customs systems and processes;

WHEREAS, the Philippines is a signatory to the World Customs Organization International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures or the "Revised Kyoto Convention", which requires Contracting Parties to simplify customs procedures and ensure that these are predictable and transparent, in accordance with international standards;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to implement, at no cost to the Philippine Government, a Preborder Technical Verification of goods prior to loading in the countries of origin for exportation to the Philippines, exclusively for the purpose of verifying the declared specifications, description, weight, volume, and country of origin, and ensuring that these goods conform to Philippine safety and quality standards and technical regulations;

WHEREAS, a single electronic invoicing system controlled by the Philippine Government is necessary to effectively monitor international trade transactions of all imported goods;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the Pre-border Technical Verification (PTV) and Cross-border Electronic Invoicing (CEI) ensures that imported goods comply with regulatory requirements before reaching Philippine borders and encourages smoother cross-border trade transactions, thereby resulting in increased efficiency and cost reduction as it reduces time and resources required for customs clearance and invoicing processes;

WHEREAS, there is a need to define the responsibilities, accountabilities, and liabilities of importers, exporters, PTV Accredited Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies (ATICC), and CEI System Provider;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024, a Committee for PTV and CEI ("Committee") was created to be composed of the Department of Finance (DOF), Department of Agriculture (DA), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Energy (DOE), Department of Health (DOH), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), Bureau of Customs (BOC), Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA), and non-voting representatives from duly recognized industry associations, mandated to provide strategic direction and policy guidance on the implementation of PTV and CEI, accreditation of PTV Testing, Inspection,

and Certification Companies, and engagement of CEI System Provider.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the above-mentioned, and subject to the limitations of their mandates conferred by law, the DOF, DA, DTI, DOE, DOH, DENR, DICT, BOC, PDEA, and the representatives from duly recognized industry associations hereby promulgate the following guidelines through this Joint Administrative Order (JAO).

RULE I PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. OBJECTIVES

- a. This JAO implements the provisions of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 on the implementation of a PTV of all imported goods and the CEI System as well as the guidelines, qualifications, documentary requirements, and procedures for the accreditation of PTV Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies and engagement of the CEI System Provider.
- b. This JAO also enumerates the roles and responsibilities of the Committee, the member agencies, importers, exporters, PTV ATICCs, and CEI System Provider.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS

As used in the JAO:

- a. Pre-border Technical Verification refers to testing and inspection of all commodities by accredited Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies prior to exportation to the Philippines for purposes of verifying in advance the declared specifications, description, weight, volume, country of origin, and other requirements as specified in the Appendices.
- b. Cross-border Electronic Invoicing System refers to a system used by a verified and registered foreign exporter to create electronic invoices (e-invoice) on a single electronic platform controlled by the Philippine Government.
- c. Accredited Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies refer to qualified Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies that possess legal, financial, and technical capabilities to implement the PTV.
- d. Cross-border Electronic Invoicing System Provider refers to an entity engaged by the Philippine government that possesses legal, financial, and technical capabilities to provide a secure web-based system for the registration of exporters and the creation of e-invoices to implement the CEI.

RULE II PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING

SECTION 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM

a. The BOC, as the primary government entity responsible for implementing customs procedures, is hereby directed to implement the PTV and CEI System, in accordance

with the strategic direction and policy guidance issued by the Committee, international trade standards, and existing laws, rules and regulations.

 The program shall be fully implemented within two (2) years from the effectivity of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE OF PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM

- a. All containerized agricultural products, non-agricultural products with health and safety issues, and other goods susceptible to misdeclaration to avoid duties and taxes, as listed in Appendices 1 to 3, are required to undergo PTV. Such Appendices shall be regularly updated in accordance with Philippine regulatory laws, rules and regulations.
- b. The following shall not be subject to PTV:
 - Goods which are already covered under the BOC Bulk and Break-Bulk Cargo Clearance Enhancement Program;
 - ii. Goods shipped in Less Container Load;
 - iii. Balikbayan boxes and personal and household effects of returning residents;
 - iv. Goods where the consignee is the Government of the Republic of the Philippines or any of its corporations, agencies or instrumentalities but not including goods imported on behalf of these instrumentalities by private importers;
 - v. Explosives, ammunition, arms, and equipment and other strategic materials certified as such by the Department of National Defense;
 - vi. Importations by registered export enterprises duly registered with Investment Promotion Agencies;
 - vii. Importations made by foreign governments or international organizations;
 - viii. Goods qualified under the Super Green Lane Facility;
 - ix. Importations made by accredited companies under the Authorized Economic Operator Program; and
 - x. Goods destined for customs bonded warehouses.

Provided, that agricultural products under items iv, vi, vii, viii, viii, and x shall not be exempt from the PTV.

- c. All goods imported, whether by air or sea, shall be subject to CEI.
- d. The following shall be exempt both from PTV and CEI:
 - Personally-owned motor vehicles under the No-Dollar Importation Program; and
 - ii. Motor vehicles for the use of an official of the Diplomatic Corps.

SECTION 5. ADVANCE CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

Goods that have undergone PTV conducted by an ATICC and have been issued a Certificate of Conformity shall be qualified for advance clearance procedure, subject to the following conditions:

 The importer has filed an import entry and paid the proper duties, taxes, and other fees on such importation;

- The information under the import entry, bill of lading, commercial invoice issued by the exporter, and Certificate of Conformity issued by the PTV ATICC match and refer to the same goods; and
- c. The e-invoice from the exporter contains a full statement of the costs of the shipment for the purpose of calculating the duties and taxes.

Upon arrival of such importation, the importer may immediately cause the withdrawal of the same from the port upon presentation of proof of payment of duties and taxes, and compliance with the applicable border regulatory rules of the DA, DTI, DENR, DOH, PDEA, and other regulatory agencies.

SECTION 6. NON-COMPLIANCE

- a. Goods without an e-invoice, have not undergone PTV when required, and those that have been issued a Discrepancy Report, shall be considered High-Risk subject to 100% physical inspection and other applicable controls by an ATICC, concerned regulatory agency, and the BOC.
- b. Failure to subject the shipment to PTV or CEI shall be subject to the following penalties:
 - i. 1st Offense: 30% of the dutiable value of the goods
 - ii. 2nd Offense: 50% of the dutiable value of the goods
 - iii. 3rd Offense: revocation of accreditation of the importer

The penalties herein imposed are without prejudice to the imposable administrative, criminal and civil penalties and fines for violations of other regulatory laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 7. FEES

Subject to the approval of the Committee:

- a. PTV ATICCs may impose a fixed fee for each physical verification of goods in the countries of origin; and
- b. CEI System Provider may impose the following fees:
 - i. annual registration fee; and
 - ii. fee for each invoice created by exporters on the cross-border e-invoicing portal.

SECTION 8. PERIOD OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM

The CEI System shall be implemented as follows:

SECTION 9. REGISTRATION

All exporters of goods to the Philippines are required to apply for registration in the CEI System annually. Only registered exporters shall be allowed to create invoices in the System. Exporters must provide information and documentation related to their company to be verified and registered by the CEI System Provider. Upon registration, the exporters shall be issued a digital certificate for the purpose of signing the e-invoices.

SECTION 10. CREATION OF ELECTRONIC INVOICES

- a. Registered exporters shall create e-invoices through the CEI System prior to exportation of the goods. The registered exporters shall provide the following:
 - i. Unique universal identifier;
 - ii. Stamp date and time;
 - iii. Invoice number:
 - iv. Date of issuance:
 - Name, address, and contact details such as phone and email of the exporters, importers, customs brokers, and manufacturers;
 - vi. Name, address, and contact details such as phone and email of the traders and warehouses, if known:
 - vii. HS Code as declared by the exporter;
 - viii. Item goods description;
 - ix. Brand name of the goods;
 - x. Quantity of goods in weight and unit;
 - xi. Incoterm:
 - xii. Free-on-Board (FOB) value of goods in USD;
 - xiii. Cost of freight in USD, if known;
 - xiv. Other charges such as insurance in USD, if known;
 - xv. Total Cost, Insurance, and Freight (CIF) Value in USD, if known;
 - xvi. Country of origin, as declared;
 - xvii. Container number, if known;
 - xviii. Vessel name, if known;
 - xix. Projected date of departure, if known; and
 - xx. Port of arrival in the Philippines, if known.
- b. The registered exporters shall sign the e-invoice using the digital certificates issued through the CEI System.
- Only the CEI System Provider may authenticate e-invoices generated by the CEI System.
- d. Upon creation of the e-invoice, the same shall be shared transparently and in real time with the BOC, BIR, and the concerned regulatory agency. The e-invoice shall be available for downloading by the BOC.

SECTION 11. PHASED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION

The implementation of the PTV shall be in three (3) phases:

SECTION 12. ENGAGEMENT OF A PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION ACCREDITED TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANY AND ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY

- For goods requiring PTV, exporters shall engage the service of a PTV ATICC operating in the country of origin prior to the shipment.
- The exporter shall submit the required documentary requirements to said PTV ATICC.
- After complete submission of the required documents, the exporter shall pay the applicable fees.
- d. After the conduct of inspection, the PTV ATICC shall issue a Certificate of Conformity or a Discrepancy Report, whichever is applicable.
- e. The Certificate of Conformity shall include the following data elements:
 - Unique identifier of the e-invoice;
 - ii. HS Code as declared by the exporter;
 - iii. Description of goods as found by the PTV ATICC;
 - iv. Quality and / or grade of goods, if applicable;
 - v. Brand name of the goods;
 - vi. Confirmation that the goods meet the phytosanitary requirements of the Department of Agriculture and test report number, if appropriate;
 - vii. Quantity of goods in weight and unit as found by the PTV ATICC;
 - viii. Value of goods in USD as declared by the exporter in its commercial invoice;
 - ix. Country of origin, as declared;
 - x. Container number, if known:
 - xi. Vessel name, if known;
 - xii. Projected date of departure, if known;
 - xiii. Port of arrival in the Philippines, if known;
 - xiv. Photos of the conduct of the PTV of goods; and

- xv. Such additional testing results as may be required by the concerned regulatory agency.
- f. The Discrepancy Report shall include the following data elements:
 - i. Unique identifier of the e-Invoice;
 - ii. Reference number of the Discrepancy Report;
 - iii. Date and time and place of inspection;
 - iv. Date and place of issuance of Discrepancy Report;
 - v. Name, address, contact number, and email address of exporter, importer, and PTV ATICC;
 - vi. HS Code as declared by the exporter;
 - vii. Description of goods as found by the PTV ATICC;
 - viii. Quality and / or grade of goods, if applicable;
 - ix. Brand name of the goods;
 - x. Quantity of goods in weight and unit as found by the PTV ATICC;
 - xi. Value of goods in USD as declared by the exporter in its commercial invoice;
 - xii. Country of origin, as declared;
 - xiii. Container number, if known;
 - xiv. Lacking mandatory verification requirements;
 - xv. Photos of the conduct of the PTV of goods; and
 - xvi. Detailed reasons for issuance of Discrepancy Report.

RULE III

ROLES AND ENGAGEMENT OF PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM PROVIDER

SECTION 13. CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM PROVIDER

- Ensure the identity, existence, and operational capacity of an exporter registering in the system;
- b. Develop or customize and maintain a secure web-based CEI System for the creation of electronic export invoices. The development of the web-based CEI shall be subject to consultation and approval by the Committee before actual implementation. The system shall be controlled by the Philippine Government;
- Subject to the approval of the Committee, provide and implement mechanisms for the following:
 - i. Annual registration of exporters; and
 - ii. Authentication of e-invoices created on the system;
- d. Within one (1) month from the commencement of the Program, submit to the BOC a plan for a capacity-building program for stakeholders; and
- Conduct information campaigns outlining relevant information and processes for stakeholders.

SECTION 14. PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION ACCREDITED TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES

- Make available to all interested parties a complete address list of its offices in all countries of origin together with the names of staff who can be contacted;
- b. Conduct the inspection of goods and verification of documents covering the goods to be exported to the Philippines, in accordance with the mandatory verification requirements under the Appendices, within three (3) working days from payment of service fees and notification by the exporter of the location of the goods;
- c. Issue a digital Certificate of Conformity or a Discrepancy Report, whichever is applicable;
- d. Provide the digital Certificate of Conformity or Discrepancy Report to the BOC;
- e. Within one (1) month from the commencement of the Program, submit to the BOC a plan for a capacity-building program for stakeholders;
- f. Conduct information campaigns outlining relevant information and processes for stakeholders; and
- g. Upon receipt of a notification from the concerned regulatory agency, the PTV ATICC should be able to conduct applicable testing, on a case-to-case basis, for instances such as disease or pest outbreaks in the exporting country, and other health, safety, and environmental issues and concerns.

SECTION 15. MODE OF ENGAGEMENT

The PTV ATICCs shall be accredited in accordance with the qualification criteria and compliance with the documentary requirements set forth in this JAO.

The engagement of the CEI System Provider shall be through a competitive selection process allowed under Philippine laws, rules and regulations, including R.A. No. 9184, as amended and R.A. No. 11966.

The engagement of the PTV ATICCs and the CEI System Provider shall be at no cost to the government.

SECTION 16. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

a. CEI System Provider:

- Currently providing e-invoicing solutions in at least one (1) foreign government, using clearance model;
- Must be ISO/IEC 27001:2013 (or the latest standard) and ISO/IEC 20000-1:2018 (or the latest standard) certified for information security management systems and service management systems, respectively;
- iii. Capacity to provide and manage an electronic platform, preferably utilizing block-chain technology, to issue, store and archive electronic invoices;
- iv. Capacity to issue cryptographic digital certificate, qualified or not, for electronic signatures;

- v. Membership of good and reputable standing in the Testing, Inspection, and Certification (TIC Council) or any other similar organization generally recognized and accepted in international commerce;
- vi. With proven financial capacity;
- vii. Must not have been blacklisted by the Government of the Philippines; and
- viii. Ability to submit a capacity-building program for the BOC.

b. PTV ATICC:

- i. Currently appointed by any foreign government for a minimum of seven (7) Product Conformity Assessment programs or Technical Verification programs which have already been implemented and are still valid;
- ii. International network of offices capable of verifying goods in countries of origin:
- iii. Network of laboratories equipped to test goods exported to the Philippines;
- iv. Accredited ISO/IEC 17020:2012 (or the latest standard) network of offices;
- v. Global Certification Centers ISO/IEC 17065:2012 (or the latest standard) accredited, with at least one (1) in the Asian Region;
- vi. Competence and capability to conduct quantitative and qualitative analysis of goods traded internationally;
- vii. Ability to issue digital Certificates of Conformity and Discrepancy Report;
- viii. Capacity to issue cryptographic digital certificate, qualified or not, for electronic signatures;
- ix. Membership of good and reputable standing in the TIC Council or any other similar organization generally recognized and accepted in international commerce;
- x. With proven financial capacity;
- xi. Must not have been blacklisted by the Government of the Philippines;
- xii. Ability to submit a capacity-building program for the BOC; and
- xiii. Existing branches in the Philippines.

SECTION 17. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

a. Class A - Legal Documents:

- Certified true copies of the following:
 - Company Registration Certificate with Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws, and updated General Information Sheet;
 - 2. Business Registration Certificate or Mayor's Permit or similar for Principal Place of Business;
 - 3. Tax Certificate of Registration which contains the Taxpayer's Identification Number and VAT Registration Number;
- ii. Statement under oath attesting that the applicant corporation, joint venture or consortium is not listed in the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Consolidated Blacklisting Report as a blacklisted entity; and
- iii. Certification under oath that each of the Class A legal documents submitted in satisfaction of the eligibility requirements is an authentic and original copy, or a true and faithful reproduction of the original, complete, and that all statements and information provided therein are true and correct.

b. Class A - Technical Documents:

 Company profile with names and designations of the company's Board of Directors or partners;

- ii. Statement of the company's principals and key staff with their qualifications, technical competence, experience and other related expertise;
- List of Product Conformity Assessment contracts or Technical Verification contracts for imported goods which have already been implemented by foreign governments and are still valid;
- iv. Certified copies of ISO 17020 and 17065 accreditations;
- v. Certified copies of ISO/IEC 27001:2013 and ISO/IEC 20000-1:2018 for information security management systems and service management systems;
- vi. List of Cross Border e-invoicing implemented contracts for which the applicant has been appointed by any foreign government;
- vii. List of e-invoicing compliance platforms, in which a clearance model is implemented by the government;
- viii. List of applicant's international network of inspecting offices capable of conducting inspections in all countries of origin to the Philippines;
- ix. List of applicant's international network of laboratories equipped to test goods exported to the Philippines; and
- x. Certificate of Membership of the TIC Council.

c. Class A - Financial Documents:

Certified true copies of the Audited Annual Financial Statements of the applicant for the last three (3) taxable years evidencing proven financial capacity submitted to the Securities and Exchange Commission, Bureau of Internal Revenue or equivalent office.

d. Class B Documents:

- Certified true copy of the valid joint venture or consortium agreement, in case of a joint venture or consortium;
- ii. Letter authorizing the Committee or its duly authorized representative/s to verify any or all of the documents submitted for eligibility check; and
- iii. Written declaration of any conflict of interest on the part of the applicant.

SECTION 18. TREATMENT OF JOINT VENTURES AND CONSORTIUMS

Applications will be considered from single entities, joint ventures, or consortiums. The qualifications outlined in Section 16 may be fulfilled collectively by all of the member companies in a joint venture or consortium. All member companies must, however, submit each of the "Class A" legal documents listed above.

Members of a consortium or joint venture shall nominate one (1) member as the 'Lead Member' for the purpose of representing the consortium or joint venture with respect to all processes in the accreditation of PTV ATICCs or engagement of the CEI System Provider. The nomination shall be supported by a Special Power of Attorney, signed by all the other members of the consortium or joint venture.

A member of a particular consortium or joint venture cannot be a member of any other consortium applying for accreditation or engagement. Also, such member/s cannot apply independently for accreditation or engagement.

SECTION 19. PROCEDURE FOR ACCREDITATION OF THE PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES

- a. A Testing, Inspection, and Certification company applying for accreditation shall accomplish and submit the Application Form together with the complete documentary requirements to the Committee Secretariat.
- Before officially receiving the Application, the Secretariat shall determine the propriety
 of the accomplishment of the Application Form and the completeness of the submitted
 documentary requirements.
- c. After officially receiving the Application, the Testing, Inspection, and Certification Company shall pay the non-refundable Application Processing Fee of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP50,000.00).
- d. In cases where, upon evaluation, a legal or technical concern is found by the Secretariat, the Application shall be referred for resolution to a technical working group of the Committee.
- e. Upon the direction of the Chairman of the Committee, the Secretariat shall calendar a meeting and issue the necessary notices to all members and interested parties. The Committee shall conduct deliberations on the application and shall issue a decision in writing approving or denying the Application, stating the reasons for approval or denial.
- f. The Committee shall inform the Applicant in writing of the outcome of its Application and, if approved, shall require the Applicant to pay a one-time accreditation fee of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP200,000.00) within fifteen (15) days from the receipt of the approval of the Application.
- g. An ATICC must post a cash bond of Twenty Million Pesos (PhP20,000,000.00) which will stand as a security in the event of any violation of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and these rules. The bond shall be constantly maintained at this amount for the duration of the accreditation. In the event that any amounts are withdrawn from the bond for violations of these rules, it is the responsibility of the ATICC to replenish the bond within ten (10) days from the debit transaction.
- h. Any Applicant whose Application has been denied may submit a second application within fifteen (15) days from the receipt of the notice of denial. The second application shall be treated as a new application and shall be subject to a non-refundable Application Processing Fee of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP50,000.00).
- i. Upon submitting proof of payment of the Accreditation Fee and Cash Bond, the successful applicant shall be issued with an Accreditation Certificate indicating the official receipt number and period of validity of the accreditation.

SECTION 20. PERIOD TO APPROVE APPLICATION OF THE PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES

The Committee shall approve or disapprove an application for accreditation within thirty (30) working days from receipt of the Application with complete supporting documents, in accordance with the requirements for accreditation as provided herein.

SECTION 21. REQUIRED VOTING FOR ACCREDITATION OF THE PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES AND ENGAGEMENT OF CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM PROVIDER

No application for accreditation or engagement shall be approved, disapproved, or renewed without the consent of the majority of the voting members representing the Government present in a valid meeting duly called for such purpose by the Chairman of the Committee. A meeting is deemed valid when at least five (5) voting members are present. Representatives of the private sector are considered as non-voting members.

SECTION 22. GROUNDS FOR SUSPENSION, REVOCATION, AND/OR TERMINATION OF THE ACCREDITATION OF THE PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES AND ENGAGEMENT OF THE CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING SYSTEM PROVIDER

The following acts or omissions shall result in the suspension, revocation, and/or termination of the PTV Testing, Inspection, and Certification Company's accreditation and CEI System Provider's engagement by the Committee:

- a. Non-compliance with the provisions of Sections 13, 14, or 19 of this JAO;
- b. Non-fulfillment of qualification criteria under Section 16 of this JAO;
- Failure to provide information of a proprietary nature obtained in the course of activities to the Committee in accordance with Section 29 of this JAO;
- d. Non-submission of monthly report in accordance with Section 30 of this JAO;
- e. Breach of PTV Accreditation Terms of Reference or CEI System Service Contract;
- Poor performance or negligence on the part of the PTV ATICC or CEI System Provider pursuant to Section 28 of this JAO;
- g. Violation of the CMTA, R.A. No. 9184, as amended, R.A. No. 11966, R.A. No. 10667, otherwise known as the Philippine Competition Act, R.A. No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act, CAOs, and other related laws, rules and regulations; or
- h. Other acts or omissions related to the provisions of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024, as deemed appropriate.

SECTION 23. INVESTIGATION

The Committee may, at any time, investigate violations of the provisions of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and/or these rules, and employ all means necessary to ascertain pertinent facts that will assist in imposing appropriate sanctions of suspension, revocation, and/or termination of accreditation or engagement, as the case may be.

The Committee shall, after investigation and determination of the presence of any of the grounds under Section 22, issue a written notice to the concerned PTV ATICC or CEI System Provider directing them to submit a written explanation within fifteen (15) working days from receipt thereof.

SECTION 24. SUSPENSION, REVOCATION, AND/OR TERMINATION OF ACCREDITATION OR ENGAGEMENT

The suspension, revocation, and/or termination of accreditation or engagement shall be decided upon by the majority of the members of the Committee within thirty (30) working days from receipt of the written explanation of the PTV ATICC or CEI System Provider.

The suspension or revocation of accreditation shall be without prejudice to the imposition of appropriate fines and penalties and the filing of appropriate administrative, civil, and/or criminal case/s.

SECTION 25. APPEAL OF SUSPENSION, REVOCATION AND/OR TERMINATION OF ACCREDITATION OR ENGAGEMENT

An appeal against a revocation, suspension, or termination of an accreditation or engagement imposed by the Committee on a PTV ATICC or CEI System Provider may be filed with the Office of the President within fifteen (15) working days from the receipt of the suspension, revocation, or termination order.

SECTION 26. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

The Committee shall be assisted by a Secretariat which shall receive and process all applications for accreditation and renewal of accreditation of a PTV Testing, Inspection, and Certification Company for consideration and approval by the Committee.

The Secretariat shall also be responsible for the following matters on behalf of the Committee:

- To keep an updated record of all documents related to the Committee, PTV ATICCs, and CEI System Provider;
- b. To have custody, storage, and maintenance of all data surveys and reports; and
- c. To perform all other functions required by the Committee and in accordance with the provisions of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024.

SECTION 27. FEE SHARING

The BOC shall collect from the PTV ATICC and CEI System Provider a service fee for monitoring and supervision of the PTV and CEI System equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the fees collected, subject to pertinent budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 28. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

The Committee shall conduct an annual performance review of the PTV ATICCs and CEI System Provider to determine their compliance with the requirements of the A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and these rules. Should there be findings of poor performance or negligence on the part of the PTV ATICC or CEI System Provider, the Committee may suspend, revoke, and/or terminate its accreditation or engagement, if deemed necessary.

SECTION 29. ACCESS TO INFORMATION

The Committee shall have access to information, documents, correspondence, and materials necessary for its oversight functions. Information of a proprietary nature obtained by a PTV

ATICC and CEI System Provider in the course of activities under these rules shall be provided to the Committee.

SECTION 30. SUBMISSION OF MONTHLY REPORT

The PTV ATICCs and CEI System Provider shall provide to the Committee a monthly report of all goods subject to PTV and CEI. The details shall correspond to those listed in Section 5 (Advance Clearance Procedure) of these rules or such other information as may be required by the Committee. The report shall be submitted not later than fifteen (15) working days after the end of each month.

SECTION 31. EFFECTIVITY OF ACCREDITATION OR ENGAGEMENT

The accreditation of the PTV ATICC shall be valid for a period of thirty-six (36) months unless earlier revoked for a valid cause.

The engagement of the CEI System Provider shall be valid for a period to be determined by the Committee taking into consideration the submitted financial model and proposed concession period.

SECTION 32. RENEWAL OF ACCREDITATION OF PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES

Applications for renewal of accreditation of PTV ATICCs shall be filed with the Committee not earlier than ninety (90) working days and not later than thirty (30) working days prior to the expiry of the accreditation.

SECTION 33. NON-RENEWAL OF SUSPENDED, REVOKED AND/OR TERMINATED ACCREDITATION OF PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION TESTING, INSPECTION, AND CERTIFICATION COMPANIES

No application for the renewal of a suspended, revoked, or terminated accreditation as a PTV ATICC shall be entertained unless such suspension, revocation, or termination has been lifted by the Committee.

SECTION 34. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any violation of any of the provisions of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 or these rules shall be grounds for the initiation of appropriate action against the PTV ATICC or the CEI System Provider without prejudice to the filing of appropriate administrative, civil, or criminal charges.

RULE IV RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

SECTION 35. COMMITTEE ON PRE-BORDER TECHNICAL VERIFICATION AND CROSS-BORDER ELECTRONIC INVOICING

The Committee composed of the DOF, DA, DTI, DOE, DOH, DENR, DICT, BOC, PDEA, and the non-voting representatives from duly recognized industry associations, shall have the following responsibilities:

 Undertake the necessary steps for the successful implementation of the PTV and CEI System;

- Formulate guidelines and implementing rules and regulations for the conduct of PTV of all commodities by ATICCs prior to the exportation of these commodities to the Philippines;
- c. Formulate procedures for the CEI System;
- d. Issue guidelines for the accreditation of Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies, including the qualifications, documentary requirements, and procedures therefor. The Committee shall ensure that the mechanism for the accreditation of Testing, Inspection, and Certification Companies shall be competitive, transparent, and in accordance with international trade standards, and existing laws, rules and regulations;
- e. Approve the fees that may be imposed by the PTV ATICCs and CEI System Provider;
- f. Regularly publish a list of PTV ATICCs;
- g. Issue updated Appendices;
- Submit to the President, through the Office of the Executive Secretary, a bi-annual report detailing, among others, the Committee's accomplishments, status, timelines and targets in the implementation of PTV and CEI System;
- Conduct a periodic review of the JAO and A.O. No. 23, s. 2024, and thereafter make the necessary recommendation to the President of any change in policy;
- j. Set timelines and targets for the phased implementation of the PTV and CEI;
- k. Approve the CEI System prior to utilization;
- Conduct information campaigns outlining relevant information and processes for stakeholders;
- m. Conduct annual performance review of the PTV ATICCs and CEI System Provider to determine compliance with the provisions of this JAO;
- n. Regularly convene once every quarter or as often as may be deemed necessary; and
- Perform such other functions as may be necessary in the implementation of this Order, or as may be directed by the President or the Executive Secretary.

SECTION 36. BUREAU OF CUSTOMS

- The BOC shall serve as the primary implementing agency of the PTV and CEI System, in accordance with the strategic direction and policy guidance issued by the Committee, international trade standards, and existing laws, rules and regulations;
- b. Request any government department, agency, or instrumentality, including government-owned or -controlled corporations, to render full assistance and cooperation to ensure the effective implementation of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and these rules;
- c. Ensure that PTV ATICCs are immediately provided updated verification requirements as provided by regulatory agencies;

- d. Issue the necessary customs regulations for the implementation of A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and these rules which shall include the right of appeal of an importer against the findings of a PTV ATICC as stated in the Discrepancy Reports;
- e. Arrange for the customs regulations to be subject to the required public consultations and hearings in accordance with Section 440 of the CMTA; and
- Conduct information campaigns outlining relevant information and processes for stakeholders.

SECTION 37. IMPORTER

- a. Inform and provide their exporters the requirements for CEI and PTV, and applicable customs and regulatory requirements of the Philippines;
- Ensure that the exporter is registered with the CEI System and creates all electronic invoices through the portal provided;
- c. Ensure that imported goods have the corresponding cross-border e-invoice; and
- d. When required, ensure that imported goods have undergone PTV.

SECTION 38. EXPORTER

- a. Register with the CEI System;
- b. Create e-invoices for goods exported to the Philippines in the CEI System;
- c. When required, ensure that imported goods have undergone PTV;
- d. Contact the overseas office of the ATICC to arrange the PTV of goods to be exported to the Philippines. Notice should be given to the ATICC of the whereabouts of the goods at least three (3) days prior to their shipment to the Philippines and the exporter must provide every facility to allow access to the goods; and
- e. Submit necessary pre-border mandatory verification requirements through the CEI system.

SECTION 39. OTHER AGENCIES

- a. Ensure that their respective regulatory mandates under special laws, rules, and regulations are fully enforced and implemented;
- Regularly update the Appendices through administrative issuances issued by the respective regulatory agencies in case of additional inclusions and/or exclusions on the aforementioned list;
- c. Immediately inform the Committee and BOC of alerts, laws, rules, and special orders, on prohibited products: *Provided*, that for new verification requirements required by regulatory agencies, notice shall be given upon the issuance of rules; and
- d. To inform the BOC, upon approval by the Committee, of the necessity to dispense the mandatory verification requirements listed in Appendix 2 prior to release in cases of public health emergency where the goods to be imported are necessary for consumption or use by the public.

Rule V FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 40. FUNDING

The initial funding requirements necessary for the implementation of this JAO shall be charged against available appropriations of the BOC and other member-agencies of the Committee, subject to pertinent budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules and regulations. Thereafter, the funding requirements necessary for the continued implementation of this JAO shall be included in the budget proposal of said agencies, subject to the usual budget preparation process.

SECTION 41. SEPARABILITY

If any provision or part of this JAO is found to be invalid, illegal, and unenforceable, the remainder of the rules shall remain valid, legal, and subsisting.

SECTION 42. REPEALING CLAUSE

All other orders, issuances, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with A.O. No. 23, s. 2024 and these rules are hereby repealed and modified.

SECTION 43. EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its complete publication in the Official Gazette or a newspaper of general circulation, and the submission of a copy hereof to the Office of the National Administrative Register of the University of the Philippines.
